# American Red Cross CPR | AED | First Aid

Be prepared when seconds count! Learn from the American Red Cross programs that set the national standard to respond effectively to adult, child and infant cardiac and choking emergencies, sudden illness, bleeding and other

life-threatening conditions. You will learn the proper use of an AED - Automated External Defibrillator and your vital role in the chain of survival. Each student will have the use of their own mannequin to practice & demonstrate

skills. Students will receive the First Aid/CPR/AED Participant Packet and State of Michigan Good Samaritan Law regarding the use of an AED unit and CPR. Adult CPR with AED, infant and child CPR and First Aid certification cards will be issued upon successful completion of course requirements (now valid for two years).

Material fee of \$15 per student is included in the price.
