

AN ORDINANCE

of the Council of the City of Berkley, Michigan
Repealing Section 14-35, Chapter 14 Alcoholic Liquors and
Amending Chapter 30 Businesses, Article III Business Licenses
of the Berkley City Code

THE CITY OF BERKLEY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: That Section of the Berkley City Code be and hereby is amended as follows:

RESCIND

Berkley City Code, Chapter 14, Alcoholic Liquors, Article II Licenses and Permits, Section 14-35
Inspections

SECTION 2: That Article III Business Licenses of the Berkley City Code be and hereby is
amended as follows:

DIVISION 1 INITIAL BUSINESS LICENSE

Existing Text of Sections 30-86 --- 30-105 to remain

DIVISION 2 CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

Sec. 30-106. Registration of properties.

Owner-occupied businesses shall register with the city their name, place of residence, and the location of each premises regulated by this article. At the time of registration, the owner shall pay a biennial registration fee which shall be established by resolution of the city council. The owner shall also furnish any other information required by the city.

The term of each registration shall be two years, except that for the first registration, businesses located on Twelve Mile, Robina, and Woodward, registration will be due **September 1, 2016**. For businesses on Coolidge, Eleven Mile and Greenfield, registration will be due **September 1, 2017**.

Sec. 30-107. Inspection of owner-occupied business properties.

1) The City shall inspect owner occupied businesses at two year intervals. These inspections shall be for the purpose of determining whether the building complies with chapters 26, 50 and 138. The City may request permission to enter any premises regulated by this article at reasonable hours to undertake an inspection. Upon an emergency, the City may obtain a court order for the purpose of inspecting any premises regulated by this article. All inspections conducted pursuant to this section shall be conducted in such a manner as to secure compliance with this article.

- 4) If any certificate of compliance or temporary certificate for compliance is revoked because of the condition of any building, the registered owner may appeal such revocation to the extent allowed by law.

Sec. 30-111. Fees.

The city shall charge a nonrefundable fee for the registration and inspection of each regulated premises made pursuant to this article. These fees shall be set from time to time by resolution of council and shall be paid by the applicant at the time of registration and in advance of each inspection or reinspection.

Sec. 30-112. Violations.


Violations of this Article shall be misdemeanors.

Secs. 30-113—30-125. Reserved.

SECTION 3: That the City Council directs the City Clerk to publish a summary of this ordinance in compliance with Public Act 182 of 1991 and Section 6.5 of the Berkley City Charter.
