The Berkley Public Safety Department is offering a 6-week Citizens Police Academy for Berkley residents and business owners. Classes will be held every Wednesday, from February 6 – March 20, 2019, from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm at the Public Safety Building, 2395 W. 12 Mile Road.

The Citizens Police Academy provides an opportunity for residents to become familiar with the mission and operation of the Berkley Department of Public Safety. The intent of this program is to provide information that will help participants know what they can do to support efforts to maintain a safe environment in the City of Berkley.

The academy is available at no charge however participants must attend all class sessions to earn a certificate of completion. To qualify for the Citizen Police Academy, residents must be at least 18 years of age and have no criminal record. Space is limited to the first 20 eligible applicants on a first come, first serve basis. Also note that:

- Academy applicants must sign a waiver and undergo a criminal history background check before classes begin.
- The dress code is jeans or khakis and athletic-type shoes. Participants will also receive an academy-issued t-shirt.
