EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II – PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The City of Berkley Department of Public Works is accepting applications from **current AFSCME employees** for the Meter Position. This is an existing job classification and requires membership in Local 1021, A.F.S.C.M.E. Council 25, AFL-CIO. **The internal posting will remain open until Friday, May 4 at 3 PM.**

The Equipment Operator II (meter position) works under the supervision of the Foreman (direct) and Director (indirect) and is classified as an Operator II (180 days entry hourly rate at \$0.20 less). While the Meter Position performs a wide range of assignments, the primary focus is the repair and installation of water meters as well as MISS DIG system field markings and related computer maintenance.

Required Knowledge, Skills, Abilities, and Minimum Qualifications:

- A High School Diploma, or the equivalent
- An "S" MDEQ Drinking Water Operator License is preferred
- Experience with the MISS DIG utility notification system
- Ability to use good judgment and initiative when dealing directly with the public
- A Michigan Commercial Driver's License (CDL)
- Basic knowledge of tools, materials, and equipment used in the repair and maintenance of streets, buildings, water and wastewater facilities and infrastructure, and parks and grounds
- Basic skill in the operation of assigned vehicles, equipment, and power tools
- Basic ability to perform a variety of tasks involving carpentry, electrical, plumbing, mechanical, and construction skills
- Ability to respond to emergencies, including MISS DIG, 7 days a week, 24 hours a day
- Other duties, as assigned
